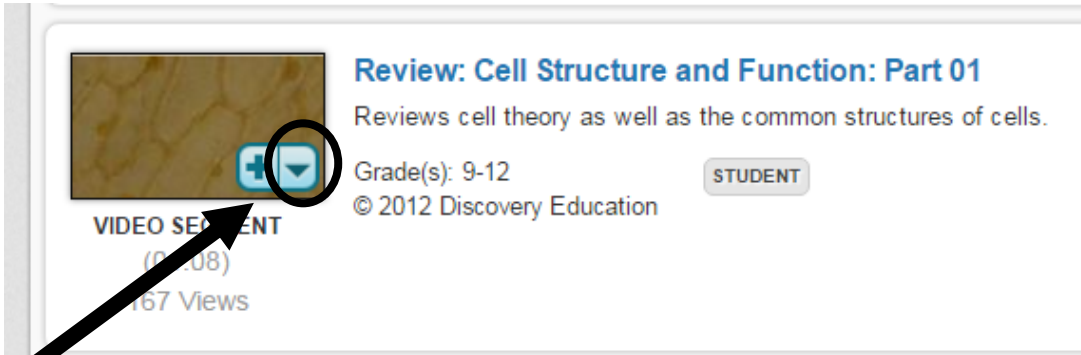

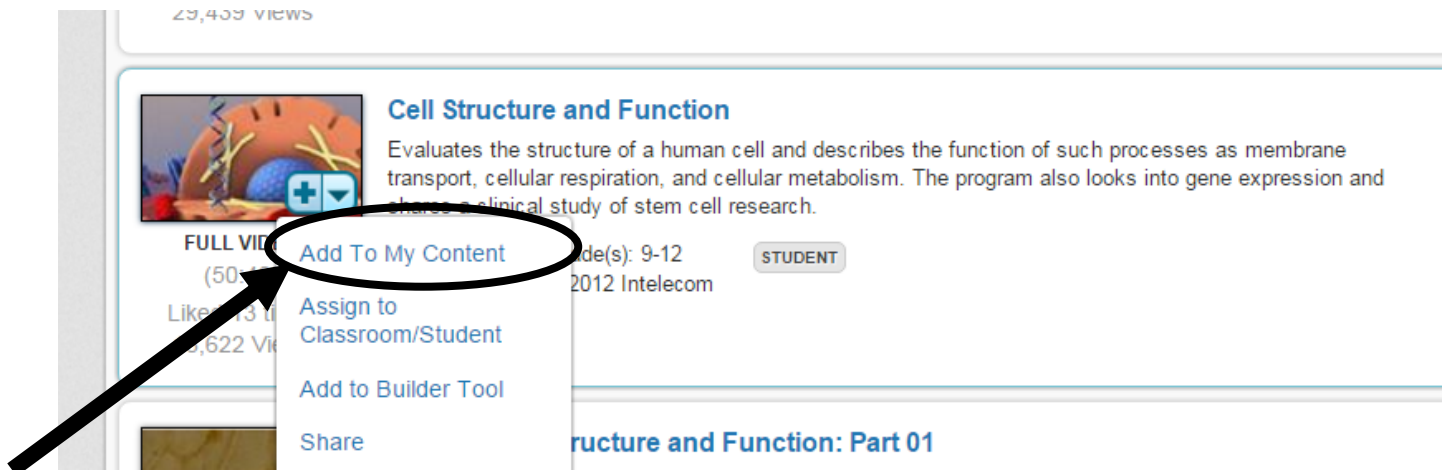

Save Your Work to a Folder:

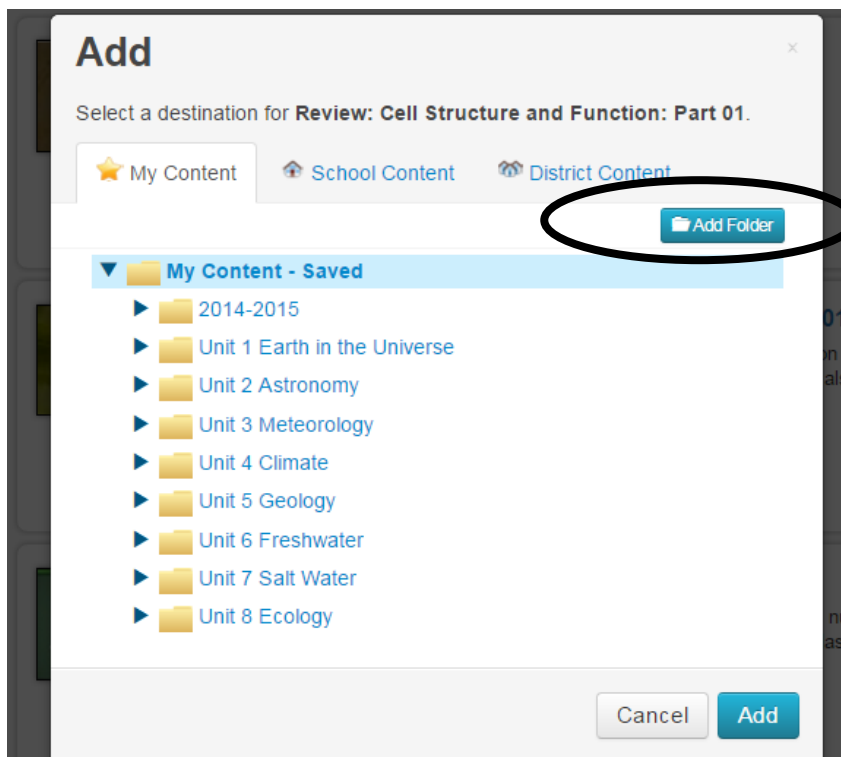
- 1) Now that you've found a resource that you like **click on the arrow** in order to save the resource to your content.



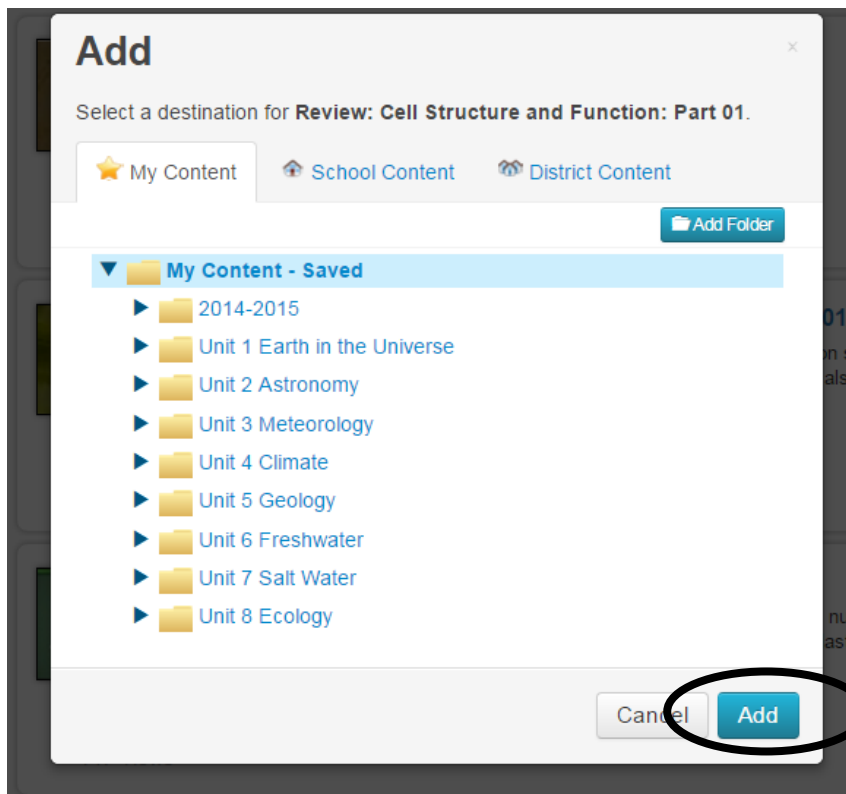
- 2) Click on **Add to My Content**
